A vision statement for PE shared with staff, pupils, governors and parents via website, noticeboard, letters, leaflet etc.

PE co-ordinator to have an informed picture of how PE is taught at Pudsey Bolton Royd and the strengths and weaknesses to inform next steps.

Play Leaders/Sports Leaders appointed who run activities at lunchtime and organise resources in PE lessons.

All staff confident at teaching all aspects of PE

Extra-curricular clubs for Years 3 and 4 runs at lunchtimes.

A well organised and well run intra-house KS1 multi-sport festival run by Young Leaders.
