Attainment and Achievement 2019

Attainment in Key Stage 2

Year 6 SATs outcomes for children attaining the expected standard:

Reading, Writing and Mathematics Combined: 57% (compared to the national average of 65%)

Reading: 65 % achieved expected standard (national: 73%)

Writing: 78% achieved expected standard (national: 78%)

English Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling: 77% achieved expected standard (national: 78%)

Mathematics: 73% achieved expected standard (national: 79%)

Scaled scores:

A scaled score of 100 corresponds to the expected national standard (there are no scaled scores available for Writing).

School average scaled score in Reading = 101

School average scaled score in Mathematics = 102

School average scaled score in Grammar, Punctuation & Spelling = 105

Progress measures:

The Department for Education currently measures progress from Key Stage 1 (KS1) to Key Stage 2 (KS2). Average progress nationally is zero, with a positive number denoting better than national average progress and a negative number denoting progress below the national average.

School average progress in Reading = -0.6

School average progress in Writing = +1.0

School average progress in Mathematics = -0.5
