Attainment in Key Stage 2

Year 6 SATs outcomes:

Reading, Writing and Mathematics Combined:

Expected Standard: **57%** (compared to the national average of 65%)

Higher Standard: **2%** (compared to the national average of 11%)

Reading:

Expected Standard: **65%** (compared to the national average of 73%)

Higher Standard: **18%** (compared to the national average of 27%)

Writing:

Expected Standard: **78%** (compared to the national average of 78%)

Higher Standard: **12%** (compared to the national average of 20%)

English Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling:

Expected Standard: **77%** (compared to the national average of 78%)

Higher Standard: **25%** (compared to the national average of 36%)

Mathematics:

Expected Standard: **73%** (compared to the national average of 79%)

Higher Standard: **13%** (compared to the national average of 27%)

Scaled scores:

A scaled score of 100 corresponds to the expected national standard (there are no scaled scores available for Writing).

School average scaled score in Reading = 101

School average scaled score in Mathematics = 102

School average scaled score in Grammar, Punctuation & Spelling = 105

Progress measures:

The Department for Education currently measures progress from Key Stage 1 (KS1) to Key Stage 2 (KS2). Average progress nationally is zero, with a positive number denoting better than national average progress and a negative number denoting progress below the national average.
