Pudsey Bolton Royd Primary School Attainment and Achievement 2023

Attainment in Key Stage 2 (KS2)

Children's attainment in Year 6 Standard Attainment Tests (SATs) or teacher assessments:

Reading, Writing and Mathematics Combined: 55.9% achieved expected standard or above (compared to the national average of 59.5%) with **6.8%** achieving the higher standard (compared to 8.1% nationally)

Reading: 67.8 % achieved expected standard (national: 72.7%) with **22.0%** achieving the higher standard (national: 29.1%)

Writing: 66.1% achieved expected standard (national: 71.2%) with **8.5%** achieving the higher standard (national: 13.5%)

English Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling (GPS): 76.3% achieved expected standard (national: 72.4%) with **37.3%** achieving the higher standard (national: 30.5%)

Mathematics: 84.7% achieved expected standard (national: 73.0%) with **22.0%** achieving the higher standard (national: 24.1%)

Science: 78% were teacher assessed as working at the expected standard (national: 80%)

KS2 scaled scores:

A scaled score of 100 corresponds to the expected national standard (there are no scaled scores for Writing).

School average scaled score in Reading = 104 (national average: 105)

School average scaled score in Mathematics = 105 (national average: 104)

School average scaled score in GPS = 106 (national average: 105)



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Key Stage 1 to 2 Progress measures:

The Department for Education currently measures progress from Key Stage 1 (KS1) to KS2 SATs outcomes. Average progress nationally equals 0.0 with a positive (+) number denoting progress better than average for all schools nationally and a negative (-) number denoting progress below the national average.

2023 School average progress in Reading = + 1.7

2023 School average progress in Writing = + 0.9

2023 School average progress in Mathematics = + 3.4

Attainment in the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS)

The children achieving a **Good Level of Development (GLD)** - the nationally expected standard for the end of Reception year:

2023 School GLD: 58% (national: 67%)

Attainment in Key Stage 1

Year 1 Phonics Screening Check Outcomes 2022:

2023 School: 76% met or exceeded the pass mark (national: 78%)

Key Stage 1 Teacher Assessments - informed by Year 2 SATs papers:

Reading: 55.0 % achieved the expected standard + (national: 68.4%) with 11.7% achieving the higher standard (national: 18.8%)

Writing: 50.0% achieved the expected standard + (national: 60.3%) with 10.0% achieving the higher standard (national: 8.2%)

Mathematics: 56.7% achieved the expected standard + (national: 70.5%) with 11.7% achieving the higher standard (national: 16.4%)

Reading, Writing, Maths Combined: 38.3% achieved the expected standard + (national: 56.2%) with 6.7% achieving the higher standard (national: 6.2%)

Science: 60% achieved the expected standard (national: 79%)
